These requirements apply to organizations with 2000 to 5000 employees and 135 to 325 concurrent users.

<b>Technical Support</b>	Microsoft® Terminal Services or Internet access  ADI Time system administrator should have the following: Microsoft® SQL Server Enterprise Manager, Microsoft® SQL Server Analyzer, and Microsoft® SQL Server Profiler.
<b>Active Directory Login</b>	To take advantage of Active Directory authentication, the workstation must be part of the <i>Windows®</i> network.

- For best performance and security, ADI strongly advises having the **latest Microsoft service packs** installed on all your servers and workstations.
- The ADI Time database can be defined in a shared SQL Server instance provided that the database server has sufficient capacity.
- Do not install ADI Time on a network domain controller due to performance and security concerns.
